





Memorandum of Understanding

between

Keimyung College University, REPUBLIC OF KOREA and James Cook University Brisbane, Joblinx and Sarina Russo Institute AUSTRALIA

Keimyung College University and James Cook University Brisbane, Joblinx and Sarina Russo Institute (hereinafter referred to as "James Cook University") in recognition of their common interests in developing a cooperative relationship based on academic pursuit, language acquisition, and cultural enrichment agree to establish the following Memorandum of Understanding.

I

This Memorandum will generally promote activities in the following principal areas:

- English Language Institute Program
- Short term language and cultural programs
- Collaborative research, instructional and cultural programs
- Exchange of students, faculty and Academic credits
- Operate the internship program
- Cooperation in other mutual interests

II

In case some affairs which are not written in this paper may happen or additional discussions for mutual cooperative activity are needed later, the two institutions progress the details through common consent, also we can insert the supplements in this MOU or conclude another agreement if necessary.

All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will respect and conform to the corresponding norms, traditions and regulations of each institution.

IV

The term of validity of this MOU is three years and extends automatically every year if any party of this MOU doesn't oppose the extension. When one of both requires amendment of revocation of this MOU, he need to notify another about the intention in written form before two months.

V

This MOU is written in English, and valid after the day when the representatives of two institutions sign this MOU.
